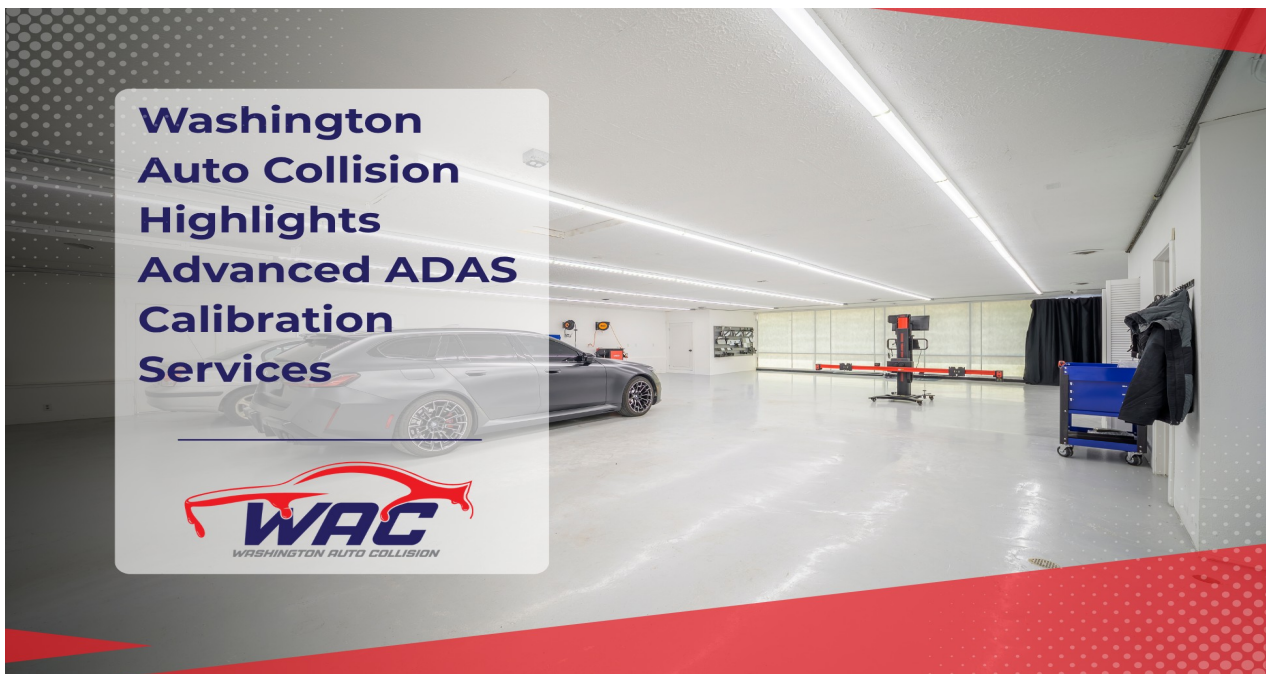




Washington Auto Collision Highlights Advanced ADAS Calibration Services

Depending on the make and model, these systems may include forward collision warning, automatic emergency braking, adaptive cruise control, lane departure warning, lane keeping assistance, blind spot monitoring, rear cross-traffic alert, parking assistance features, and surround-view camera systems.

Many of these technologies depend on cameras, radar sensors, ultrasonic sensors, and other electronic components mounted behind windshields, bumpers, mirrors, grilles, and body panels. Because these components are precisely positioned by the vehicle manufacturer, collisions or certain repair procedures may affect their alignment. Washington Auto Collision explains that manufacturer-recommended calibration procedures help verify these systems operate within the intended specifications after qualifying repairs have been completed.

The company notes that ADAS calibration may be recommended following a variety of repair situations, not only major accidents. Repairs involving bumper replacement, windshield replacement, suspension work, steering components, structural repairs, wheel alignment, or damage near sensor locations may require calibration procedures depending on manufacturer requirements. Every vehicle is evaluated individually to determine which procedures apply.

Modern collision repair requires technicians to stay current with rapidly changing vehicle technology.
