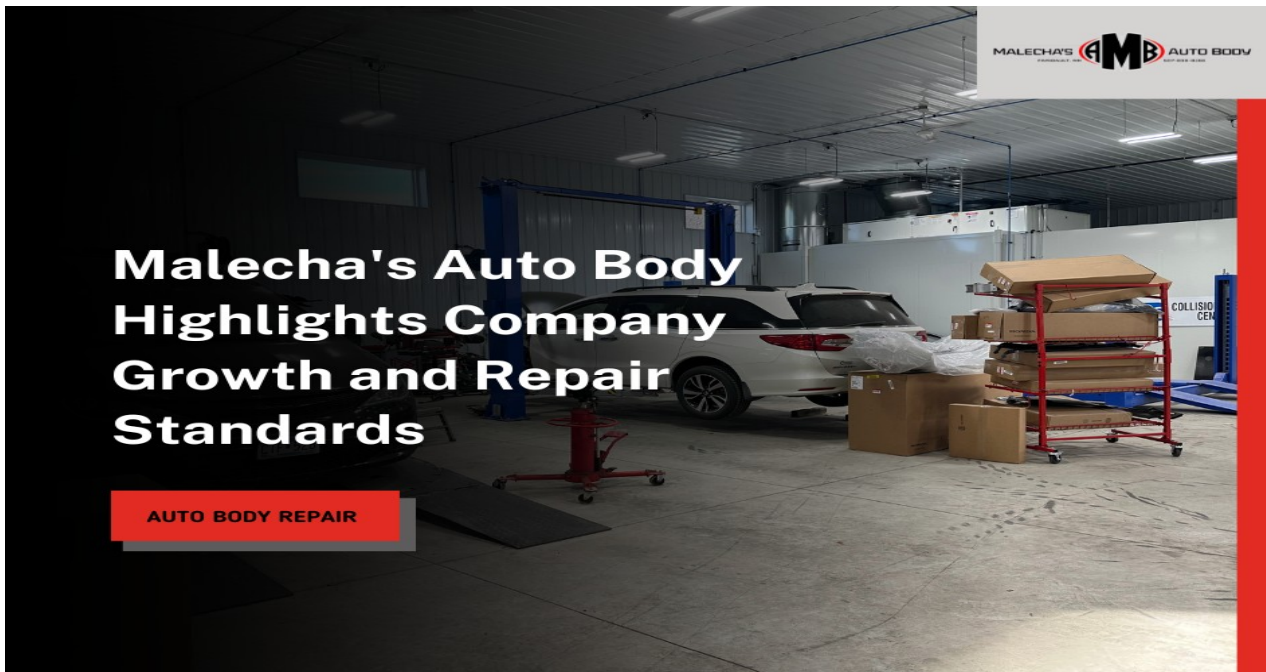




Malecha's Auto Body Highlights Company Growth and Repair Standards
